

You Change Your Life by Changing Your heart!

1. Commit your way to the Lord...

Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteousness shine like the Dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun.

(Psalm 37: 5-6)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct your paths

(Proverbs 3: 5-6)

2. Rest in the Lord...

(Matthew 11: 28-30)

3. You make a Difference!

For evildoers shall be cut off; But those who wait on the Lord, They shall inherit the earth.
